You can set up an account at <http://illiad.tamu.edu> to ask the library to:

- Scan up to 50 pages for items not already available electronically **GET IT!**
  - Request to borrow materials owned by other universities or research centers
  - Get items delivered to PSEL from other campus libraries

### Keeping Track of My Library Resources . . .

Manage your research and information through My BookBag at <http://library.tamu.edu/portal>:

- save links to frequently used e-journals
- group and search selected sets of databases
- save articles in folders for review later
- set up alerts for new articles in your subject area
