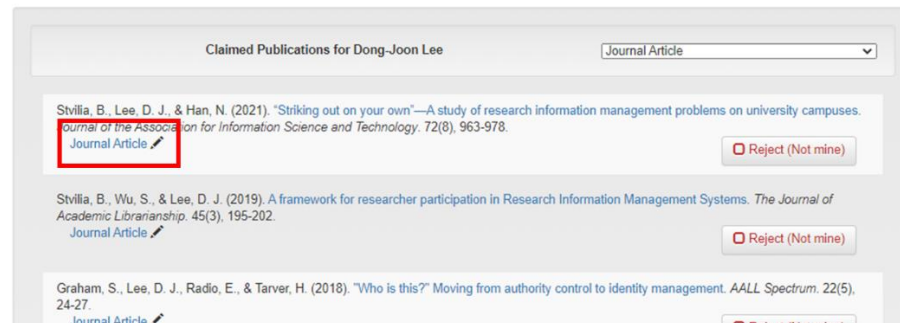
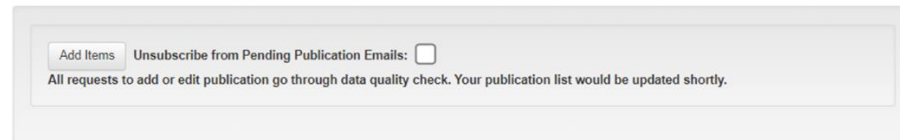

## Steps

1. Locate and click the **“EDIT MY PROFILE”** button to the right of the main tabs on the Scholars@TAMU homepage
2. Locate the **Publications/Patents** in the middle of the Scholars@TAMU main section bar.
3. Find your article that you want to add UN SDG tag(s), and click the **Type of the article with a pencil mark**. A dialogue box will appear.
